

## Camps and Classes Terms & Conditions

## **Before the Event**

All students must be fully enrolled and paid before the start of camp or class. There is a nonrefundable registration fee of \$25 per camp or class. All cancellation requests must be made at least two weeks before the start of each event via <a href="mailto:email

Enrollment closes once a program reaches capacity. If a camp or class is already closed, you may <u>email</u> us to be added to a waiting list, but we cannot guarantee a position from the waiting list. A student's place is not secured until tuition is paid in full through our website.

By completing the registration, you grant permission for photos of your learner to be used by Mindwalk Learning for instructional and promotional purposes only. If you do not want their photograph to be used, <u>email</u> us at least one day before the event starts.

A first aid kit will be available on the premises, and our trained staff will administer minor treatment, if needed, that can be resolved by a bandaid or ice pack. The electronic signature on the registration form also allows the staff to obtain any necessary medical treatment in the event of an emergency when the parent/guardian cannot be reached. The cost of this emergency medical treatment is the sole responsibility of the parent or guardian.

Please make sure your child has breakfast or lunch before coming to camp or class. We will have water available but no scheduled snacks, unless otherwise stated in the program description. Likewise, please make sure they have their medication before coming to the event as we are not able to administer medicine. If there are extenuating circumstances, please <a href="mailto:emailt

## **During the Event**

For camps and onsite classes, students should wear comfortable clothes and shoes appropriate for the weather and that can get dirty, unless otherwise noted. On the first day, all campers will receive an official camp t-shirt, which we encourage them to wear each day. (Classes do not include t-shirts.) If students bring any personal items, such as a refillable water bottle or a backpack, please make sure it is clearly labeled with their names. We cannot be responsible for personal items, including cell phones. Students will not be allowed to use cell phones during

camp or class unless related to the learning activity. Any cell phone in use without permission will be retained by staff immediately and can only be retrieved by the approved adult at the time of pick up.

Please call Mindwalk Learning at the number listed on the website before the start of each day of camp or class if your student will be absent. Sick students cannot be allowed to stay. Not attending the event for any reason does not entitle a refund. Registration reserves space, time, and staffing, whether or not your child attends. With online events, our staff will *try* to reschedule a meeting, if possible, but we cannot guarantee this service.

Learners may <u>not</u> be dropped off at any onsite event without being properly enrolled for that week; anyone not enrolled will not be allowed to stay. For security purposes, all registered attendees must be dropped off no sooner than 15 minutes before the event and picked up within 15 minutes after the event's time as listed on the website. Violations of this rule may result in their enrollment being canceled immediately.

The staff at Mindwalk Learning work diligently to ensure a positive atmosphere and experience for all learners. As experienced educators, we work with all learners to recognize and modify challenging behavior, and we believe everyone deserves second and third chances when possible. We also keep parents informed in such cases. However, Mindwalk Learning reserves the right to remove any child from camp or class at any time. We will not tolerate any unsafe or bullying behavior.
